

STANDARD CONCENTRATE MIXING CHART

Finished Products	EVERGUARD	Water*	Coverage
1 qt (32 oz)	1/2 cup (4 oz)	3/4 qt	500 ft ²
1/2 gal (64 oz)	1 cup (8 oz)	1 3/4 qt	1000 ft ²
1 gal (128 oz)	2 cups (16 oz)	3 1/2 qt	2000 ft ²
2 1/2 gal	1 qt (32 oz)	2 1/4 gal	8000 ft ²
5 gal	1/2 gal (64 oz)	4 1/2 gal	16000 ft ²
10 gal	1 gal (128 oz)	9 gal	32000 ft ²

^{*}Quantities are approximate

For extreme foraging problems you can increase to a maximum of 1 part concentrate to 6 parts water.

DO NOT EXCEED THESE MIXING PARAMETERS.

<u>For difficult deer problems</u>: You can increase the concentrate Mix to: 1 in 7 ratio (1 part concentrate to 6 parts water). For example: 4 oz. concentrate plus 24 oz water, gives you 28 oz of ready-to-use. You don't need to be exact when mixing, but try to be close, keep in mind the 1 in 7 to 1 in 9 ratios and **do not exceed these parameters**.

Applying Finished Product to Plants: SHAKE WELL BEFORE EACH USE. It is not important what type of sprayer you use. What is *very important* is the adjustment to the sprayer nozzle. Adjust nozzle to shoot a 10 to 15 degree spread of small droplets which covers at least, 70% of the leaf surface area. If the nozzle shoots a solid stream, then you are wasting the product. Adjust the nozzle too fine and the droplets atomize and drift away from the plant. Remember to avoid use on windy days or when your plants are wet.

Storage & Safety: Unused portion of mixed concentrate can be safely stored in the sprayer container. Simply re-shake the sprayer container to begin using again. Can be safely stored for extended periods of time after mixing without compromising the quality of the product. Store in a cool dry location inaccessible to children and pets.
